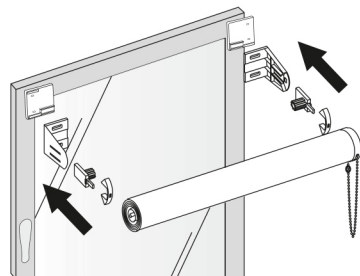
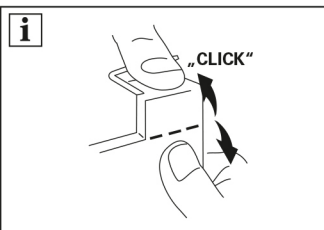

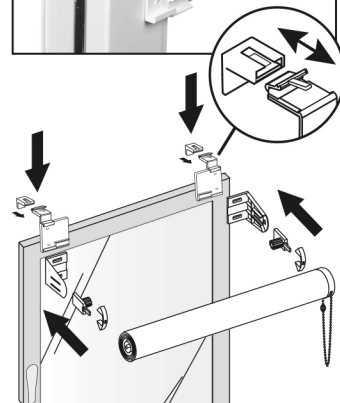
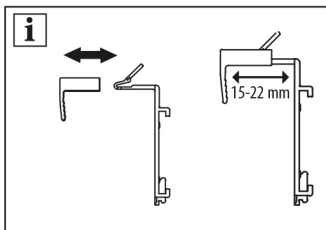
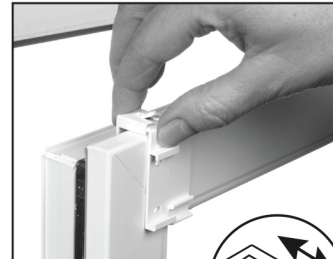
Diagram 2 shows a perspective view of the rectangular frame. Arrows indicate the placement of the corner caps on the top and bottom edges.



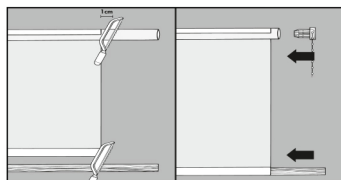
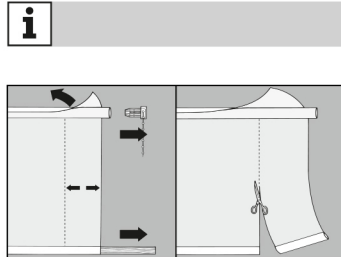
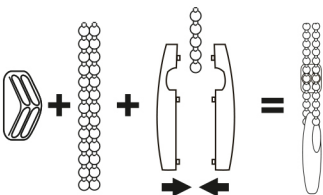
